Lyon Glace Patinage invites you to take part in the Masters 2026 synchronized skating competition, organized under the aegis of the F.F.S.G. in accordance with national and international regulations. This competition is open to teams in the Senior ISU, Junior ISU and Novice Advanced categories. These teams will be able to take part in monitoring according to the schedule published after pre-registration.

This event is also open to the following categories: Junior B, Senior B and Basic Novice to take part in on-ice and indoor monitoring with a member of the technical panel and a judge. Monitoring will take place element by element. (Coach's choice)

Team skaters must comply with ISU rules and hold a competition or secondary license in the "Synchronized Skating" discipline.

PRE-REGISTRATION

Clubs can pre-register for the competition and monitoring by submitting the pre-registration form no later than **September 6, 2026 - 20:00 Central European Time (UTC+1)**, via →: [Link](#) so that we can begin planning your participation.

The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the number of teams per country or to refuse registration.

if the maximum number of teams we can accommodate has registered for the competition.

REGISTRATIONS

Clubs can register via the registration forms that will be sent to you after pre-registration. They must reach us by **September 27, 2026 - 20:00 Central European Time (UTC+1)**

- The registration fee for the competition is **€295** per participating team.
- The registration fee for the monitoring is **€150** per team for Junior, Senior, and B teams not participating in the competition; and **€90** per team for Novice team(s) (B team(s) participating in the competition).

Payment must be made by bank transfer no later than the registration deadline (bank transfer fees are the responsibility of the participating clubs).

A copy of the payment must be sent as soon as possible to Lyon Glace Patinage at sroque@lyonglacepatinage.fr. Team registration will be valid only upon receipt of the registration fee.

The registration fee and meal reservations are non-refundable if a withdrawal occurs less than 3 weeks before the competition.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: September 27, 2026

JURY COMPOSITION

For each category, the jury is made up of a maximum of one Technical Panel (1 Technical Controller, 2 Technical Specialists and 2 Data Video Replay Operators) and a panel of a minimum of 3 judges, including 1 Referee.

Each participating country (other than France) may nominate a judge, preferably from the ISU list for the 2026-27 season.

The first meeting of the Officials will take place at the ice rink on **Friday, November 6, 2026**, or **Saturday morning, November 7, 2026**, depending on the schedule set by the Referee.

The Organizing Committee will cover accommodation, meals and travel expenses for all French competition officials. For foreign judges appointed by their nation, only accommodation and meal expenses will be covered.

The travel expenses of the Referee and the Technical Panel are borne by the organizer.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Each team in the competition will be allocated an official practice time on the competition rink described in the table below, on Friday and Saturday mornings according to the draw.

The music will start:

- In the practice of 10 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 6:00 minutes
- In the practice of 11 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 6:30 minutes
- In the practice of 12 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 7:00 minutes

STARTING ORDER

For each category, the starting order will be determined by drawing lots.

The draw will be carried out by computer after the registration deadline and will be announced on Sportity.

For the free program, the starting order will follow the reverse order of the results of the short program.

ACCREDITATION-WELCOMING

All participating teams and all competition officials are invited to be accredited upon arrival at the Ice Rink.

A welcome service will be set up at the ice rink for the duration of the competition from **Friday, November 6, 2026, 5:30 p.m.** at the ice rink.

Each team will receive 1 welcome pack and passes (1 President, 1 Team Manager, 2 Coaches per club and 2 Chaperones per team).

RATING SYSTEM AND PROGRAM COMPOSITION

The scoring system is based on the ISU Judging System.

Depending on the category, the composition of short and free programs must comply with ISU regulations (see ISU regulations).

FORMS

A Drive link to complete the Forms online will be sent by CSNPAS to each pre-registered club on **September 7, 2026**. Forms must be completed by **September 27, 2026**.

For Forms 1 to 4, any changes must be requested by e-mail to: **sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr**, copy **sroque@lyonglacepatinage.fr** copy **cpernet@ffsg.org** and this until **October 31, 2026**. After this deadline, changes can only be made at the time of accreditation.

MUSIC

All teams must provide in advance their competition music of excellent quality on an MP3 file either directly as an attachment or using a download link (via we-transfer by e-mail) not later than **October 17, 2026**, at **sroque@lyonglacepatinage.fr** and **cpernet@ffsg.org** and **sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr**. Each e-mail must contain a single music file or download link. The subject of the e-mail must be in the format "**Category, program name and team name**".

The volume level of the music as determined by the Medical Commission must not exceed 85-90 Pressure dB Sound Level throughout the rink.

Each team must bring their competition music on a USB key to the competition as a backup. Each USB key must be placed in an envelope bearing "**Category, program name and team name and exact duration of the music (not skating time)**".

FORM PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET

The PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET (Form 4) must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by the registration deadline. However, program content may be modified up to the time of accreditation. The modified form must be sent to the Technical Delegates:

sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr, **cpernet@ffsg.org**, **sroque@lyonglacepatinage.fr** by **October 31, 2026**. After this deadline, Form 4 must be submitted at the time of accreditation. It is not permitted to submit it directly to the Officials.

CLOSING CEREMONY - PODIUMS

All participants are required to be in costume for the announcement of results and presentation of awards.

Teams must take part in the closing ceremony according to the arrangements made by the organizing club.

ORGANISATION

The organization of the competition is the responsibility of the Organizing Club, which reserves the right to make any arrangements necessary for the smooth running of the competition.

All decisions relating to such arrangements will be taken in agreement with the Referee.

RIGHT TO IMAGE

All participants in the competition (skaters, accompanying persons, spectators,) authorize the use of their still or moving images, representing them, without any financial compensation.

This right is valid before, during and after the competition.

RESPONSIBILITY

In accordance with ISU rule 119, the Fédération Française des Sports de Glace and the Competition Organizing Committee cannot be held responsible for any injury or damage to competitors or officials.

A medical service will be set up by the Organizing Committee for the duration of the competition and training sessions to provide emergency medical care at the competition venue.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Team Managers must be able to communicate for each skater, the medical information necessary in case of emergency or accident.

This information should include, but not be limited to, the following, to assist medical personnel:

- Allergies
- Existing illnesses (asthma, etc.)
- Current treatments and medications
- Vaccination record
- Blood type
- Use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances

AWARDS

The top three teams in each category receive an award.



ANTIDOPAGE

Doping control may take place and will be carried out in accordance with current ISU anti-doping rules and procedures (ISU communications No. 2366 and 2568 or any new updates to these communications). No skater is permitted to consume alcohol during the competition.

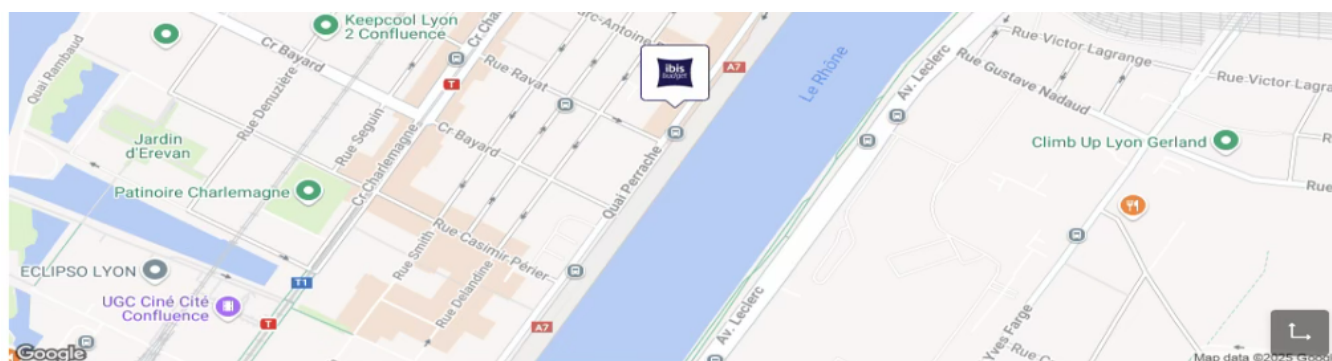
TEAM ACCOMMODATION AND CATERING

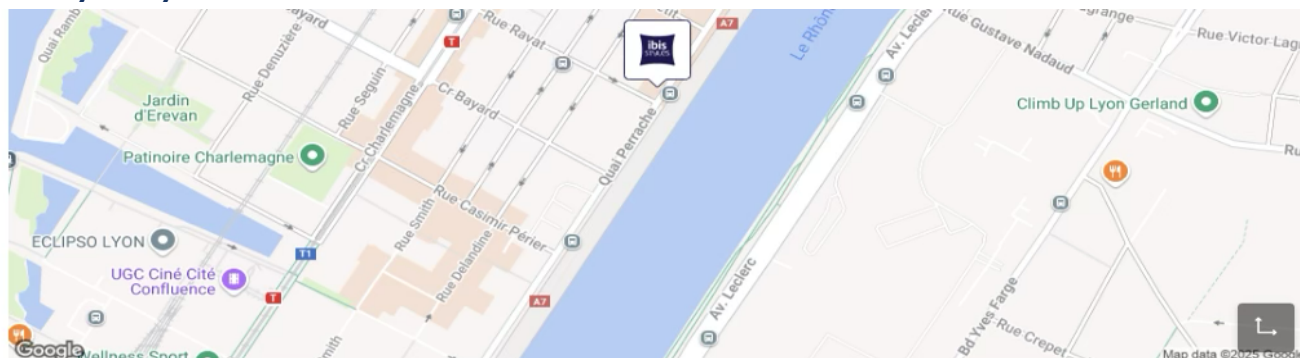

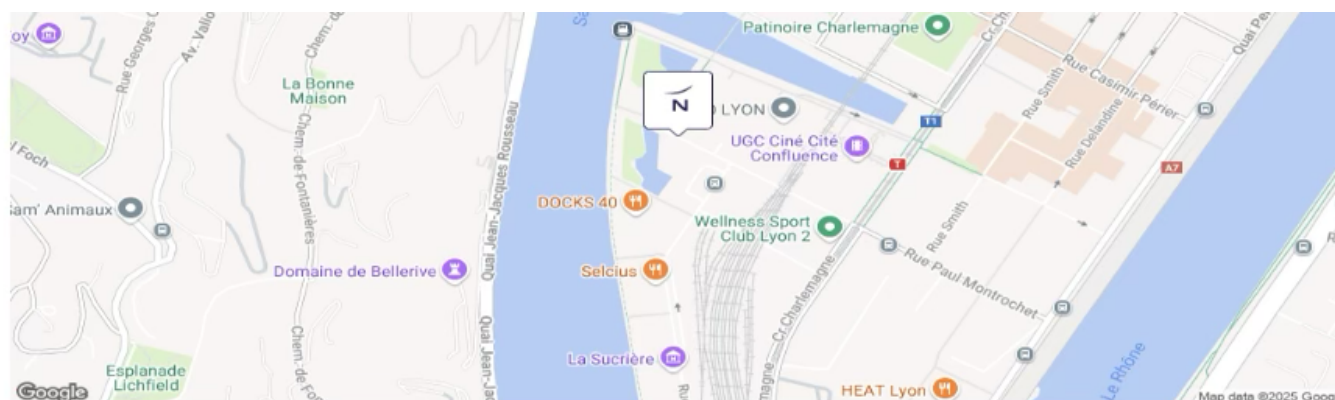
